Entrepreneurship Development cell of Sanskardham Kelavani Mandal's J. M. Programmes were arranged through online as well as offline mode (by taking appropriate COVID-19 precautionary measures). The team had tried to give maximum support to the participants in developing their skills. The following programmes were conducted by the Entrepreneurship Development Cell.

The EDC conducted three days' workshop on "A Door Open for Earning" from 13th to 15th of July, 2020. The main objective of this workshop was to teach students various skills and enable them to become independent by earning through selling various products. The experienced resource persons taught students the skills of preparing earrings and various types of greeting cards, as well as preparing 'Best out of waste' products.
