NSS REPORT

AREA LEVEL ACTIVITIES

1. Paper Bag Making Activity

The SKM's NSS unit conducted a paper bag-making activity from 3^{rd} Jan 2022 To 12^{th} Jan 2022 (9 days). The objective of this activity was to make the students aware of the use of paper bags that would help to fight climate change and environmental pollution. A total number of 25 (9 days) (12 female and 13 male) students participated in this event. The bags were later distributed to vendors.

2. Paper Bag Distribution

The NSS unit of J. M. Patel College had undertaken Paper Bag Distribution Activity on 15^{th,} February 2022 in which, the volunteers distributed paper bags in the adopted area i.e. Hanuman Nagar, near Goregaon station and nearby college area. The Paper bags were given to the vendors. There were 30 (15 male and 15 female) volunteers who took part in the activity.

8. Vision Eye Center Inauguration

The NSS unit of SKM''s Jashbhai Maganbhai Patel College of Commerce, organized a Vision Eye Centre on college premises in collaboration with Indian Development Foundation. The Vision Eye Center Inauguration was done on 5th January 2022. The vision center began at 09.00 a.m. with a short inaugural function where in medical social workers Dr. Amul Sahu along with his team were given a floral welcome. The chief guest Dr Narayan Iyer Co-Founder& CEO, of Indian Development Foundation delivered speech on awareness of Eye Checkup for the students. There was total 45 NSS Volunteers (25 females and 20 males) who took part in this event.

9. Vision Eye center:

The NSS unit of SKM''s Jashbhai Maganbhai Patel College of Commerce, organized a Vision Eye Centre in college premises in collaboration with Indian Development Foundation. The campaign helped students & people from place nearby area to get their eye check done from 8th January to 3rd March 2022. It was conducted twice a week for this duration. It benefited a total of 274 no. of people. There was total 65 NSS Volunteers (32 females and 33 males) who took part in this event.

10. Survey of Waste Management:

The NSS unit of J. M. Patel college conducted "Survey of Waste Management" on 28th ,29th and 30th March 2022. The main objective conducing the survey was to know whether the people awareness level of people regarding management of domestic waste. 405 forms were collected. Total 25 NSS volunteers (17 females and 8 males) participated.

Patel College along with Unity for Good cause and IDF undertook a clothes collection drive for Chiplun Flood from 28th July 2021 To 6th August 2021, to provide clothes to all needy people who are affected by the flood. 30 volunteers 10 females and 20 males) took part in the activity.

The SKM's NSS unit in collaboration with Unity for Good Cause (NGO) and IDF(NGO) organized Food Collection Drive from 7th August to 9th August 2021 for Chiplun food distribution, to provide food (Dry ration) to all needy people who were affected by the flood. 30 volunteers (13 females and 17 males) took part in the activity.

14. Food and Clothes Distribution Drive

The SKM's NSS unit in collaboration with Unity for Good Cause (NGO) and IDF(NGO) organized a Food and Cloth distribution drive for the poor on 10th August & 11th August, 2021 from 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM. In this activity volunteers distributed food to the needy people who were affected by the Chiplun flood. A total of NSS volunteers took part & with the help of Unity for Good Cause (NGO), we covered more than 150 poor and needy people and distributed food to them.

UNIVERSITY LEVEL ACTIVITIES

36. How NSS Can Change Life Seminar


